(((VIP-Travel))) How do I get my boarding pass on Frontier Airlines?

Getting your boarding pass on Frontier Airlines is a simple + 1 - 855 \(\times \) 510 \(\times \) 5815 process, but it's important to understand how Frontier structures its check-in options, since the airline's low-cost model means certain conveniences—like printing a boarding pass at the airport—may come with extra fees.
