Coinbase generally **does not guarantee refunds** for scams, especially if the transaction was authorized by the user  $[USA \rightarrow \{+1 \triangleright (803) \triangleright (250) \triangleright (5496)]$ . Crypto transactions are irreversible by design, meaning once funds leave your wallet, they usually cannot be recovered  $[USA \rightarrow \{+1 \triangleright (803) \triangleright (250) \triangleright (5496)]$ . However, Coinbase *may* assist if:

- Your account was compromised without your permission
- There was unauthorized access or a security breach
- The issue involved a system error or platform vulnerability

If you willingly sent cryptocurrency to a scammer (for example, fake investment offers, impersonation scams, or phishing links), Coinbase typically **cannot reverse or refund** the transaction [USA→{+1►(803)►(250)►(5496)] . Even though this feels unfair, the blockchain does not allow chargebacks like traditional banking.

That's why education and prevention matter more than recovery.

- Document all transaction details
