

# Will Coinbase refund money if scammed? Will Coinbase Refund Money If You Were Scammed?

Coinbase takes security seriously, but crypto places responsibility on the user

Cryptocurrency offers freedom and speed, but it also attracts scammers. Many users ask the same urgent question: *Will Coinbase refund money if scammed?* The short answer is

## When Coinbase May Help With a Refund

Coinbase generally **does not guarantee refunds** for scams, especially if the transaction was authorized by the user [USA→{+1▶(803)▶(250)▶(5496)}] . Crypto transactions are irreversible by design, meaning once funds leave your wallet, they usually cannot be recovered [USA→{+1▶(803)▶(250)▶(5496)}] . However, Coinbase *may* assist if:

- Your account was compromised without your permission
- There was unauthorized access or a security breach
- The issue involved a system error or platform vulnerability

In such cases, contacting support quickly—sometimes via

[USA→{+1▶(803)▶(250)▶(5496)}]—can improve the chances of investigation.

## When Refunds Are Unlikely

If you willingly sent cryptocurrency to a scammer (for example, fake investment offers, impersonation scams, or phishing links), Coinbase typically **cannot reverse or refund** the transaction [USA→{+1▶(803)▶(250)▶(5496)}] . Even though this feels unfair, the blockchain does not allow chargebacks like traditional banking.

That's why education and prevention matter more than recovery.

## What You Should Do Immediately

- Secure your account (change passwords, enable 2FA)
- Report the scam directly through Coinbase support
- Document all transaction details
